God Created Heaven and Earth - Genesis 1-2:3

I wonder what it was like before God created light? I wonder how God felt when he looked at the beautiful new world? I wonder which part of God's world is your favorite? I wonder why God created so many different animals, birds and fish? And I wonder if you have a favorite? I wonder what is the most impressive part of this story to you? I wonder why it's important for us to know?

Caring for God's Creation

Spend some time this week caring for the world around you.

Let your preschooler help you plant summer flowers, clean the beds, water, or even repot an inside plant. Let him feel the dirt in his hands and then run his hands under water, noticing the difference between land and water. Help him to investigate the plants and their parts and enjoy God's perfect creation.

Or make a simple bird feeder at home. String cheerios on a piece of yarn to make a cereal necklace. Hang the necklace on a tree branch and watch as the birds come to feast. Take a moment to pray and thank God for making so many kinds of fish and birds.

Creation Walk

As you take a walk together, notice all of God's creation. Think of each day of creation, and see how many things you can see that God created on that day. Or name a color and see how many things of that color your child can find. Praise God for his creation and his creativity!

Creation Collage

God is the most amazing artist! Collect as many nature objects as you can find - such as leaves, twigs, flowers and seed pods. Using these materials create a collage that will remind you of God's magnificent creations.

Creation Quotes

Look up your favorite Bible verses or quotes about nature. Using sidewalk chalk, write them on your fence, sidewalk or driveway.
