- I wonder if he believed God's promise?
- I wonder why it was important for him to build an altar?
- I wonder what he thought the next time he went to Bethel? Did he remember his dream? Was his altar still standing?
- I wonder what is the most important part of this story to you?
- I wonder if you have a sacred, holy space?
